**By Road:** From the South, exit the M1 at junction 43 on the M621. From the West, exit the M62 at junction 27 onto the M621.

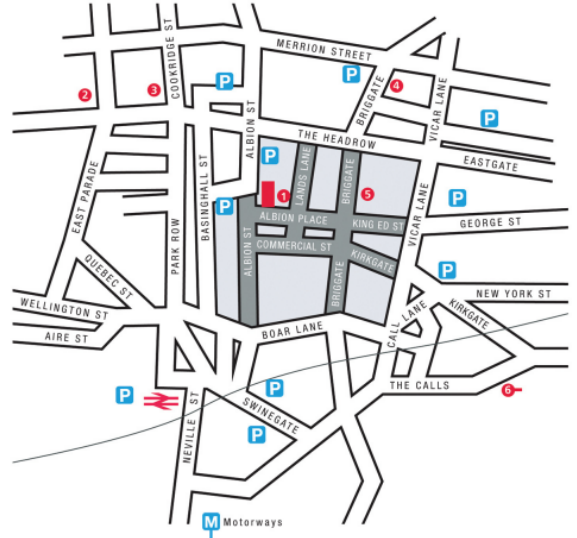
From the East, exit the M62 at junction 29 onto the M621, take junction 3 and follow signs for the city centre.
